Hybrid meeting was held November 16



Approximately 50 GAN members and Friends attended the hybrid Annual Member meeting held at the Busch library and on Zoom on November 16. Presenters included Jessica Leys, who provided an overview of the AACo Department of Recreation and Parks, Mike Lofton, who reviewed public water access issues in the County, Paul Christensen, who reviewed the past and planned activities of the Communication Committee, and Matt Minahan, who presented goals for 2023.

Two recently elected members of the Board of Directors were introduced: **Sarah Knebel**, Executive Director of [Scenic Rivers Land Trust](#), and **Pat Huecker**, a citizen planner and advocate from the Crofton area who served on the [Plan2040 Citizens Advisory Committee](#).
