March session (TBD): Putting it all together and taking action to achieve strategies for affordable and equitable communities.

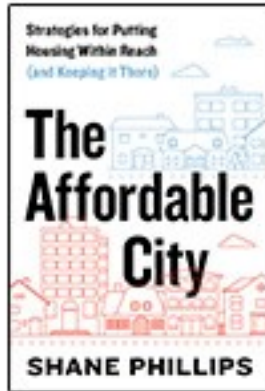
Using the information gained and participant's stories, action will be taken to show elected
